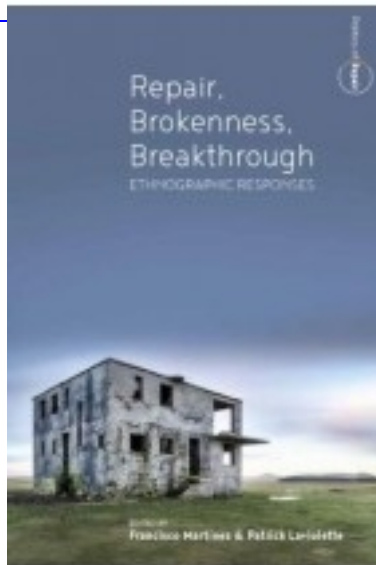

What are the social relationships that take place around repair? And how much tolerance for failure do our societies have?"
